# SC Instructional Materials Adoption



- SC Board of Education adopts instructional materials
- An advisory committee meets annually to create SC funding priorities
- Subject areas are staggered on a six year cycle

# SC Board of Education



- SBE appoints a review panel (September)
- A 30 day public review is held (November)
- Formal recommendations are made to SBE (December)
- For this adoption, materials received a secondary review of content prior to the March release

# District Five Policy and Procedures



- Teachers begin reviewing materials as they are released by SCDE and are made available through vendor samples and/or regional caravans.
- Policy IJJ requires the formation of textbook committees to assist in selecting materials.
- Recommendations from the administration and the textbook committees are submitted for local board approval
- Orders are submitted in early May in order to ensure materials arrive before the start of the upcoming school year
