




Spartanburg School District Five's enrollment is projected to increase by 16% over the next five years and surpass 14,000 students by 2034.

- District's oldest elementary school
- Is nearing its capacity
- Aging building core

Byrnes Freshman Academy

- Originally built in 1973
- ADA compliance concerns
- Significant electrical upgrades needed
- The 2016 facility study recommended that this facility be considered for replacement.

Costs



The amount of the referendum will not exceed

\$200,000,000.

Resolution



- Order to hold a referendum
- Form of the ballot
- Must publicize referendum in local newspaper three times.
- Declaration of intent to reimburse certain expenditures
- Authorizes the board chair, secretary, and superintendent to execute necessary documents
