



- The administration recommends a change order to the Byrnes Parking Lot/Baseball Field Relocation Project to extend fiber from the baseball field to the transportation office for an additional \$36,600.
- This district owned fiber would prevent the loss of Internet, telephone and GPS location services at the transportation office due to AT&T outages.
- We would increase from a 100-mg circuit to a 10-gig direct connection.
- A network switch could be eliminated, which saves us about \$8,000 over ten years.
- We currently pay \$5,145 annually to AT&T for the existing fiber.
- If approved, this new fiber would greatly improve our network connection to the transportation office and we would recoup the up-front cost over 7 years.
