


Three Main Areas of Concern

- Comprehensive Health Education
- ► Teachers teaching outside of certification
- Credit-bearing courses at the high school

Comprehensive Health

- We have been working on a solution, adding requested information
- FOIA filed for exemplars
- ▶ For 2018, it was noted that evidence was made available
- Summer 2018
 - ► Team will convene in June (science teachers, PE teachers, counselors at all levels)
 - ► Create a steering document that shows each standard, who is responsible for teaching it, time involved, etc.
 - Will submit to SDE upon completion for review and feedback prior to deadlines

Types of Disease and Prevention

Teacher certification

- Guidance manual that matches subjects and courses with certification areas
- Blurry areas:
 - ▶ Elementary/Intermediate
 - Special Education
 - High School Social Studies
- New process in place to extract all courses and teachers by school and grade once schedules are made to verify that we have people in the correct spots
- Principals have been reminded as they shuffle teachers and make new hiring recommendations that they ASK in advance if there are any questions regarding certification

Course numbers

- Each course CIP code can only appear once on a transcript
- Issues in elective areas with a large number of courses or courses that students take multiple times
 - ▶ <u>3530</u>10CW is used for Concert Band I (Fall)
 - ▶ <u>3530</u>01CW is used for Symphonic Band I (Spring)
 - Students who take this combination of band classes as a freshman would have two instances of '3530'
- Solution:
 - We are working with teachers and the high school to create a series of Local Board Approved Courses that will allow us to have independent numbers for each course (June approval)
