It will continue to serve the students in the Duncan attendance zone

It will be open to students from outside the zone who provide their own transportation, if space is available

If space is no longer available, the decision will need to be made on which students are allowed to attend (lottery, audition, etc.)

Model of Arts Delivery

School of the Arts Model

Students complete the same academic curriculum as other D5 students

Schedule is altered to provide extra time for arts instruction

All arts instruction is delivered by the arts teachers

Digital Art

Students will combine art and technology to produce digital art.

Instrumental Music

Students will learn the music standards in the context of world percussion while also being exposed to the various world cultures the instruments represent.

Theatre

Theatre will allow students to try out roles, learn to work together, and think creatively. Participation in Theatre will strengthen language and communication skills.

Students will have experiences in theatrical elements such as: Puppets Role Play Improvisation Pantomime Monologues Group Scenes Full-Scale Productions



Students in dance class will move and perform in a non-threatening way that emphasizes originality and creativity. In dance, students will focus on developing flexibility, collaboration, and body awareness.

15 minutes of dance instruction can count towards the required physical education time.

Schedule

Each Academic Arts class will be 45 minutes

Students in K4 and K5 will have 3 Academic Arts per week Music, Art, Dance

Students in 1st Grade will have 3 Academic Arts per week Music/Instrumental Music, Art/Digital Art, Dance

Students in 2nd-4th Grades will have 4 Academic Arts per week Music/Instrumental Music, Art/Digital Art, Dance, Theatre

Facilities

Duncan currently has rooms available to host the new arts classes

The current Art and Music rooms are some of the largest in the district and will continue to be used for that purpose

The stage in the cafeteria is able to host small-scale productions and performances
