District Five Special Services Philosophy:

- Intensive Early Intervention Services for children in preschool through grade 4
- Self-contained classes, with smaller student/teacher ratios

The elementary grades have experienced an increase in children identified with disabilities this school year. The reasons are multifactored:

- School referrals for testing increased 75% due to the number of children receiving RTI services who were not making progress, including Speech
- Child Find and Babynet increases
- Children transferring into D 5

Justification for Increasing Self Contained at River Ridge from 1 to 3 classes:

- Wellford classes have 24 children projected for 2 classes, grades k5 4<sup>th</sup>. The Defined Minimum Program for elementary self- contained class size is 12:1. Both classes operated with 14 -16 children in each class, requiring extra TA's.
- 2. River Ridge is projected to have 32 children for 1 class. The class operated with 15-17 children, requiring extra TA's.
- 3. Duncan is projected to have 11 children, grades  $2^{nd} 4^{th}$ , with room for growth.
- 4. Adding 2 more SC classes, k5 4<sup>th</sup> at RRES will start the year with 10 11 per class, with some room to grow.

Intermediate through High School Special Ed Services are more inclusive. Fewer students are self-contained. Those needing specialized ELA and Math instruction are being taught in a resource class setting. Students receive Science and Social Studies instruction from the grade level teacher, with modifications.

Note: ALL students are tested on grade level, with the exception of the Satellite Children at Abner Creek. Each self-contained child's PASS test scores will be reported to their attendance/zoned school in PowerSchool.
