

# Student Growth Measures



- Growth measures are based on, and determined by, the academic growth students make during an interval of instruction.
- Two methods of collecting student growth measures:
  - Statewide Test-Score-Based Measures (VAM)
  - Student Learning Objectives as a vehicle for organizing data on assessment measures



#### **Summative Rating Decision Matrix**

SLO RATING	PERCENTAGE OF ATTAINMENT
Exemplary	All students met growth goal and 25% or more exceeded it
Proficient	≥80% students met their growth goal
Needs Improvement	51-79% of students met their growth goal
Unsatisfactory	$\leq$ 50% of students meet their growth goal

- A teacher who has POSITIVE growth for ALL students can not receive a Student Growth rating of less than 'Needs Improvement'
- A teacher whose VAM Growth measure is at Level 5 will have their Final Rating INCREASED by one level
- A teacher whose VAM Growth measure is at Level 1 will have their Final Rating DECREASED by one level
