- 4 Special Needs Route Buses (One out-of -district bus) Seat Capacity range - 29-50





SC Statues Governing Transportation

59-67-105 - Ride Time & Seating Capacity - No more that 90 minutes on State bus

59-67-415 - Parent Responsibility - Parents are responsible for safety, conduct, and the timely arrival of their children to, from, and at the designated school bus stop.



SC Statues Continued

59-67-420 - Extent of Transportation to be Provided

- One and one-half miles (1.5) school attending
- Three-tenths (.3) of mile walking distance of the residence of student
- No transportation of student who attends outside school attendance zone or school district
- Hazardous stops
- 3 & 4 year- old transportation
- Two-tenths (.2) of a mile required between stops

 - 4 Small 14 passenger buses
- 11 Large 72-81 passenger buses
- 7 Blue Activity
- 4 Mini Blue Activity
- 3 Yellow Activity Dual purpose as route buses

 Testing with middle school shuttles to improve accountability as students scan on and off the bus.




Routefinder Pro Software

Infofinder LE and Infofinder Mobile

For Principals and Secretaries

- Unlimited number of District personnel access
- Access to student route assignments and stops
- View routing maps
- Teachers request field trips online
- Principals approve field trip request
- Allow district personnel to monitor the status of field trip request
- Document events/accidents or incidents at stops
- Access reports and individual routes

Challenges
