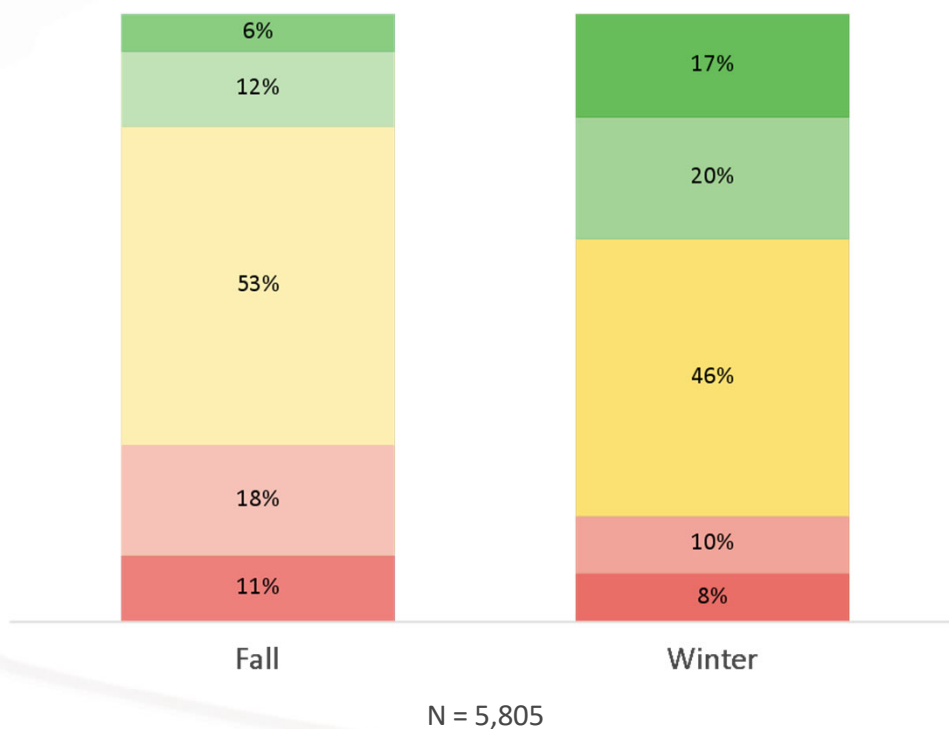

3+ Grades Below

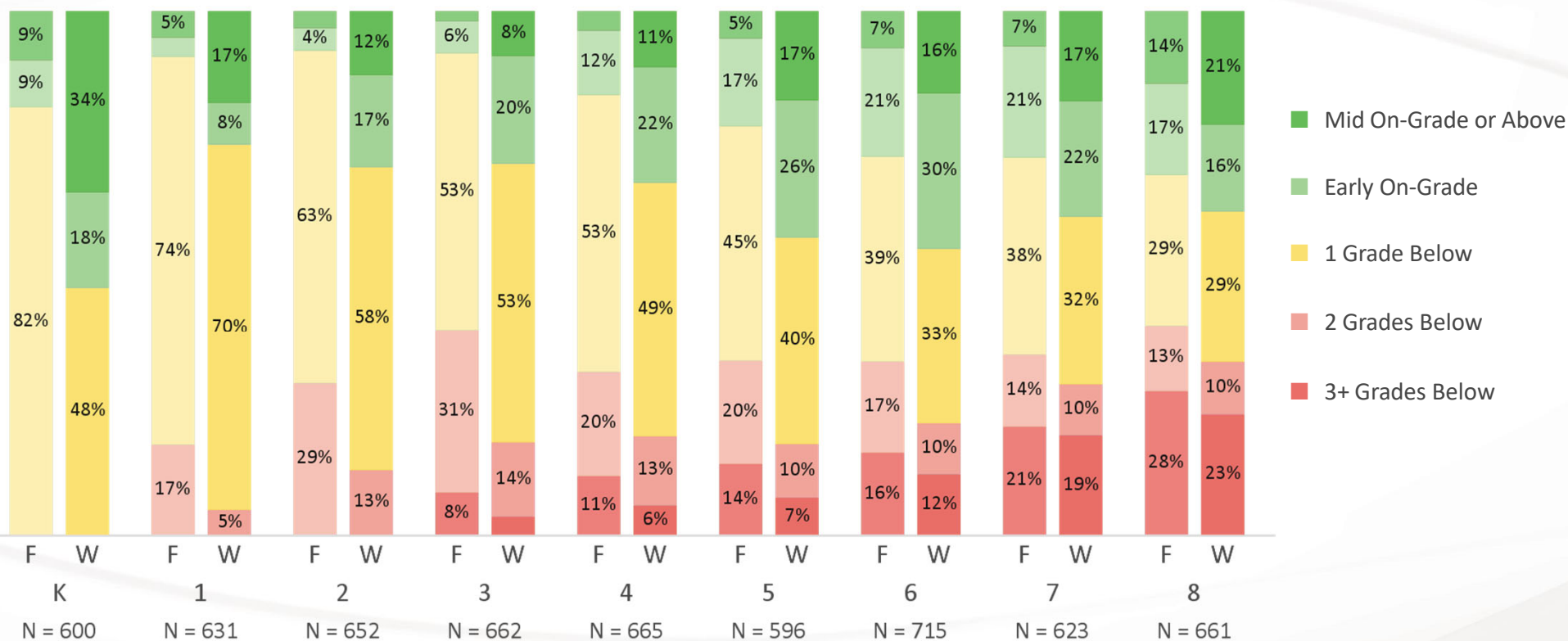
Students placed three or more years below grade level.

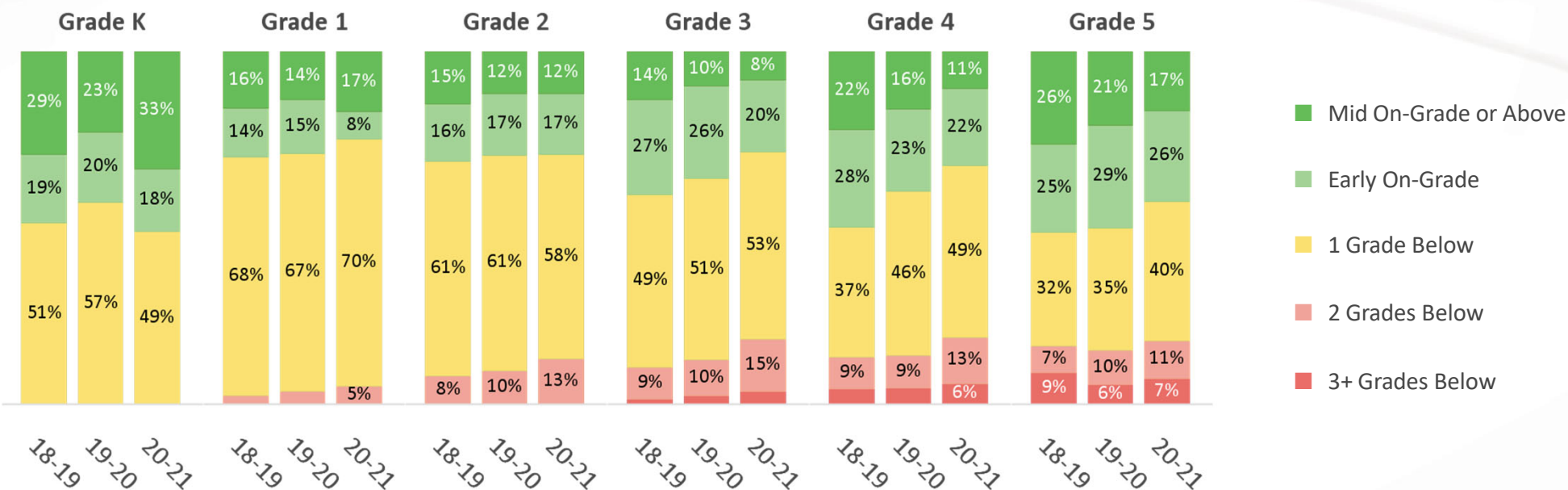
Placement Distribution, Fall 20-21 to Winter 20-21

Placement Distribution, Winter 18-19 to Winter 20-21

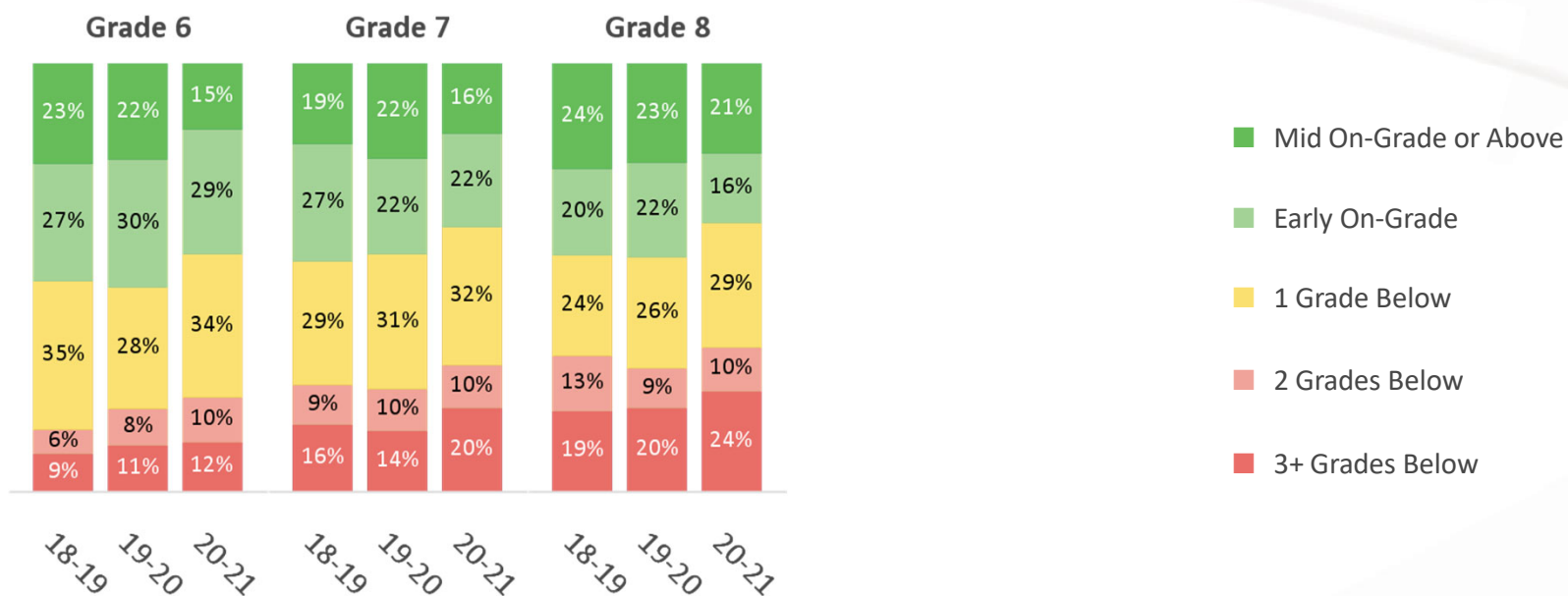

Placement Distribution, Winter 18-19 to Winter 20-21

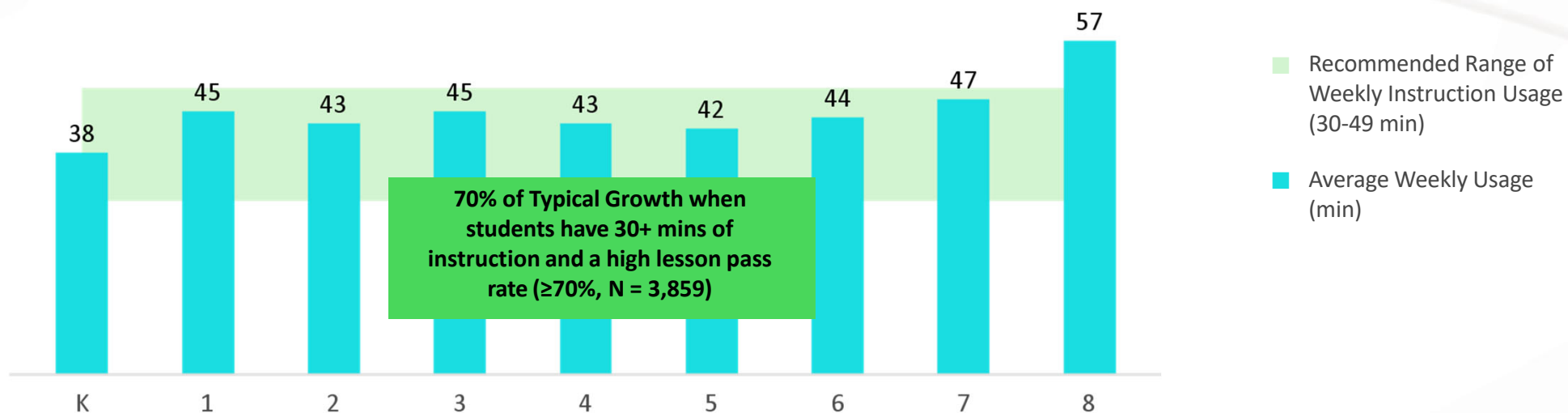

How Long Are Students Spending on Personalized Instruction Overall?

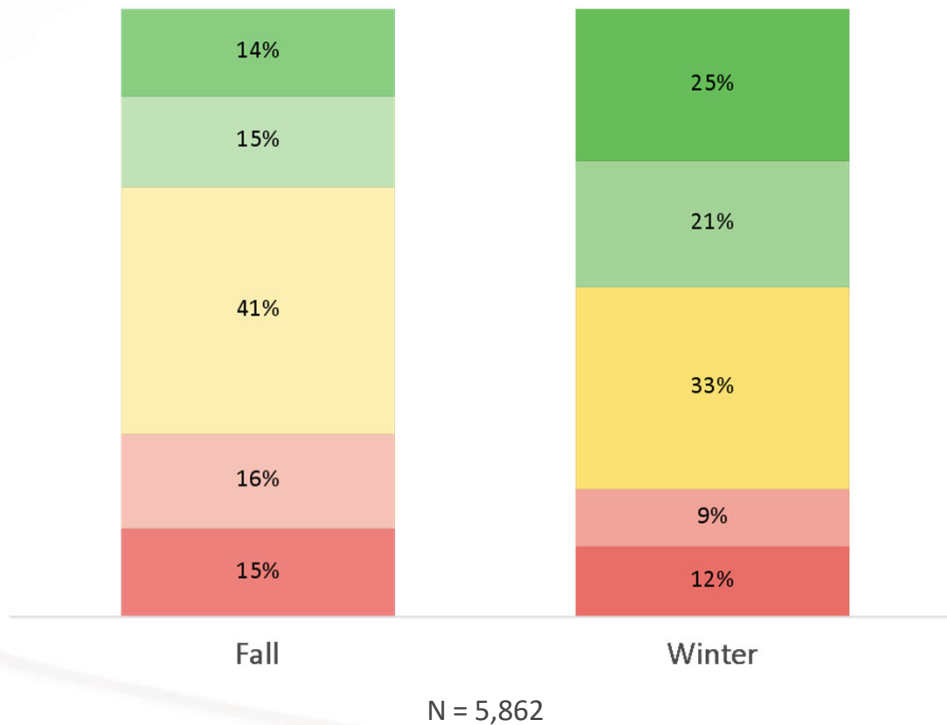
Average Weekly Usage of Personalized Instruction

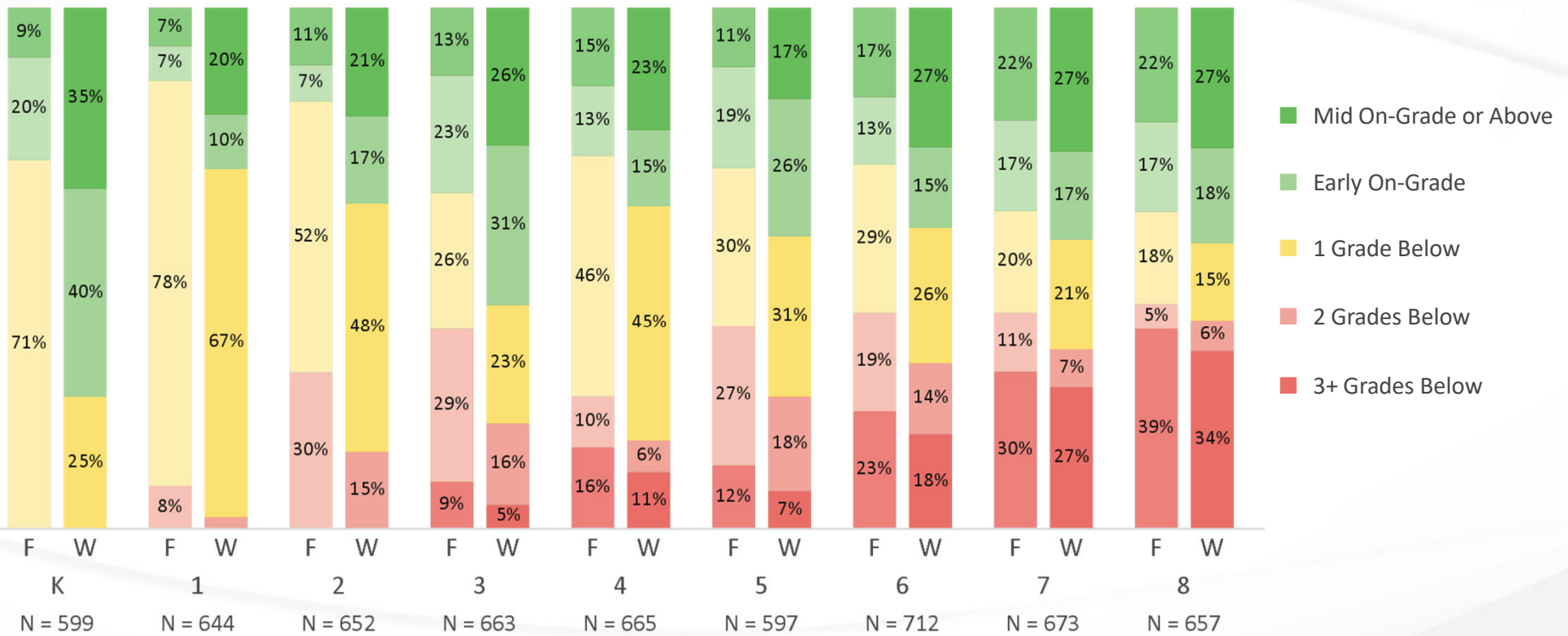

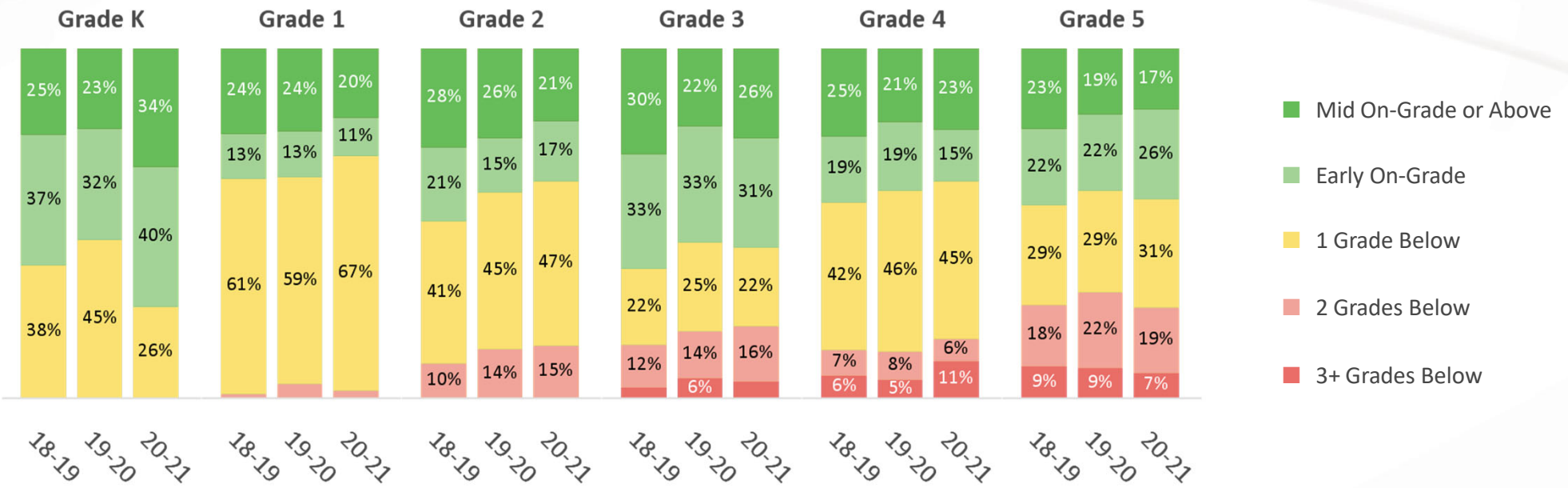
Placement Distribution, Fall 20-21 to Winter 20-21

Placement Distribution, Winter 18-19 to Winter 20-21

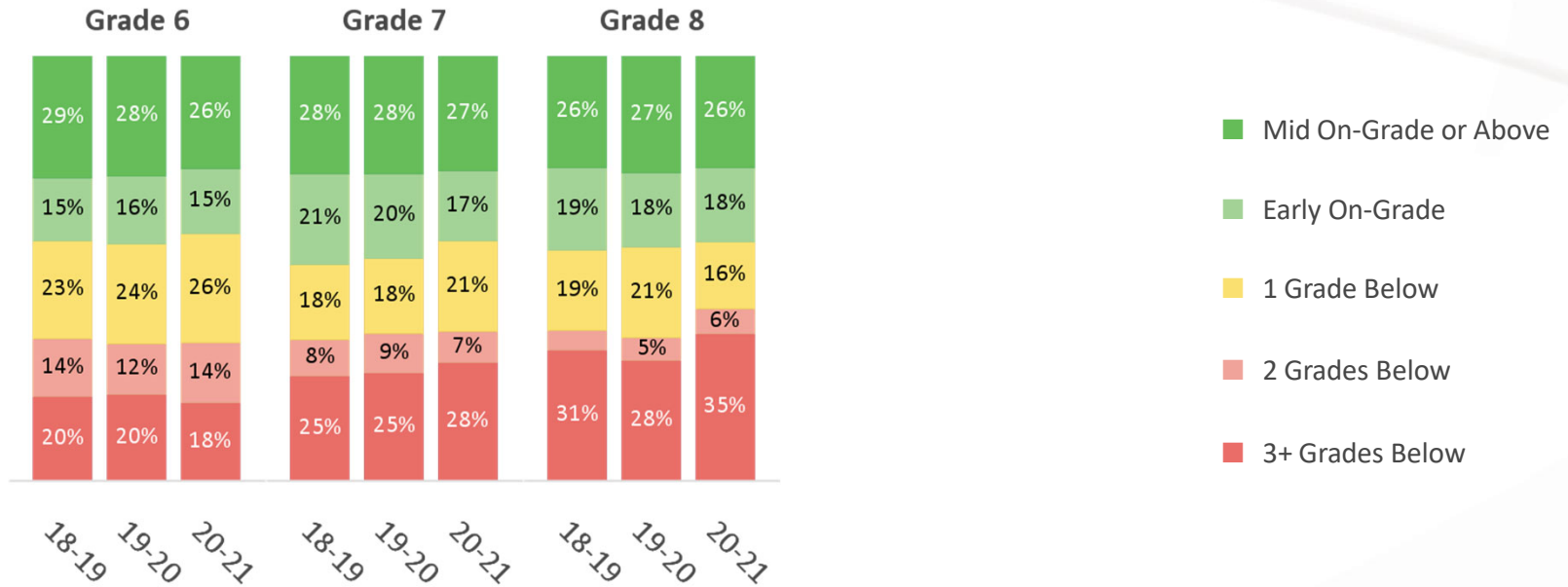

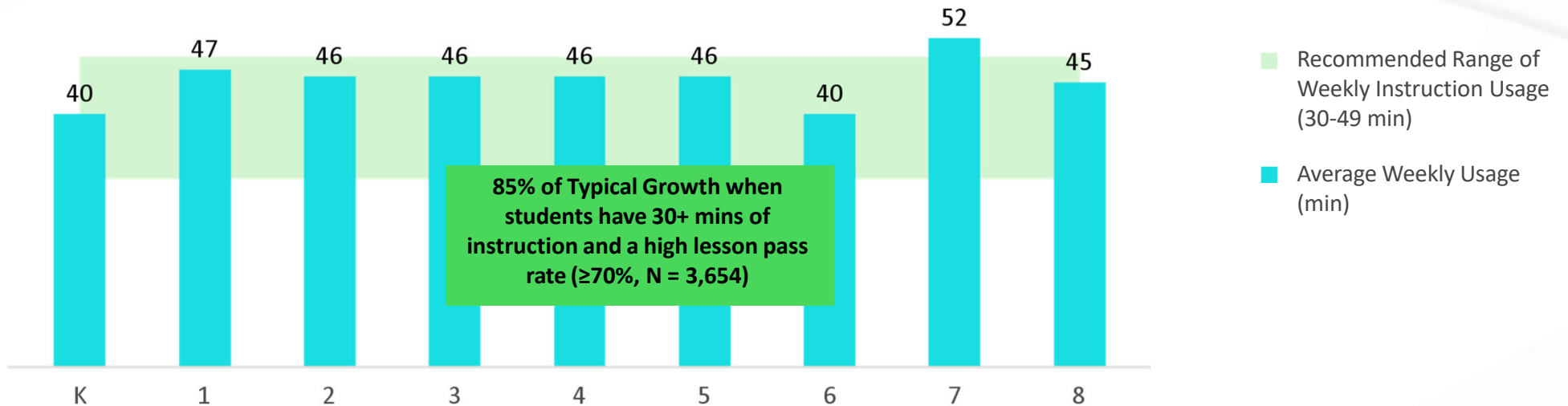

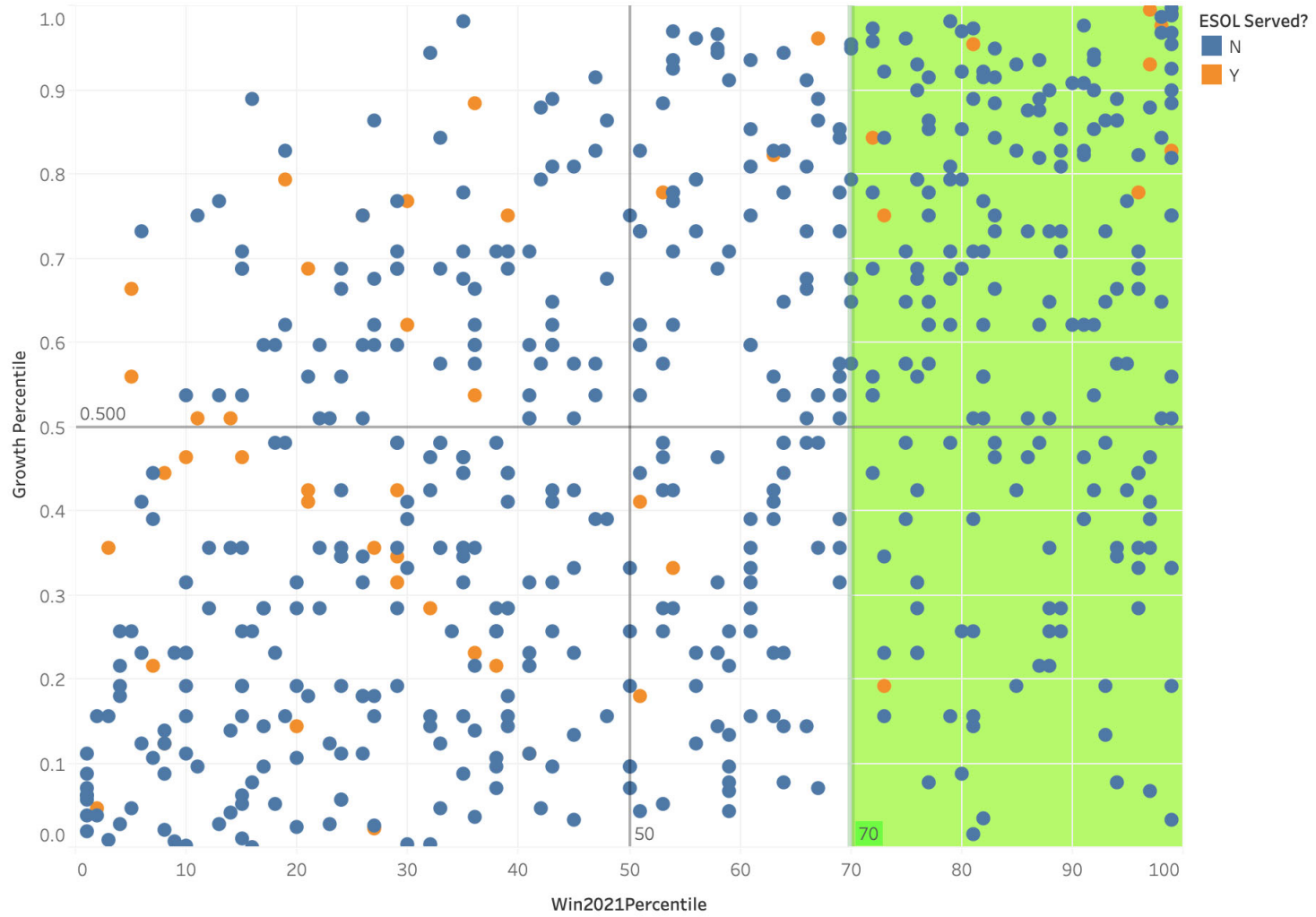
